**113. Planning for the right homes in the right places: Government Consultation:** To discuss the Council's response.

**It was Resolved:** That a Working Group consisting of Cllr. Oliver, Cllr. Nike, Cllr. Stringer, Cllr. Gibson and the Clerk should meet and formulate the Council's response and given the short timescale for the response, it would be circulated to Councillors.

- **114.** Three way Meeting with Pendle Borough Council and Nelson Town Council Regarding Victoria Park: A verbal update on the meeting held Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October by the Chairman and Vice Chairman at which the future maintenance of Victoria Park and the funding was discussed. Proposals on possible funding formulae were tabled by Barrowford Parish Council and the Nelson Town Council representatives said that they would discuss the matter with Nelson Town Council before responding.
- **115.** Friends of Barrowford Memorial Park: Verbal update on the meeting held Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October. Cllr. Nike and the Clerk reported that discussions regarding the lake had taken place and that the Clerk as a member of the group had drafted a possible solution to the silt problem in the lake which would if feasible would be less disruptive to the public use of the park than some previously suggested schemes. A meeting on site has been arranged to examine the viability and potential cost of the work. A report would be made to the next meeting.
- **116.** Neighbourhood Plan Update: The Clerk reported that the consultation would begin on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October and run until the 1<sup>st</sup> December and that everything was ready for the start.
- **117. Parish Newsletter:** The Clerk reported that the Newsletter had been delivered or with Councillor's for delivery, he thanked Councillors for their efforts in delivering the newsletter.
- **118.** Car Park at Holmefield House: The Clerk reported that the Councils Consultant was still waiting for approval from LCC on the condition relating to the entrances.

**119.** Holmefield House AED Awareness Session: Cllr. Windley reported that the session was attended by around 10 people and was very successful. The Clerk is compiling a list of people who wish to attend a future session and will arrange another session in due course.

#### 121. Report of the Clerk:

- Higherford Residents Action Group: At the group's request a meeting was held on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October between the group, Higherford Councillors, the Chairman and the Clerk. Numerous topics and aspirations were discussed with common ground being found on most items. Better communications between the groups and early discussion on potential future projects were discussed.
- 2) 2018-19 Budget: It is coming to the time of year when the initial work on next year's budget needs to commence. The Clerk will start the preliminary work over the next few weeks and add the item to a future agenda.
- **3) Internal Auditor:** The Clerk has received an email from Mr. Pickering, informing the council has decided to retire and will not be available for next year's Internal Audit. The Clerk is making enquiries for another Internal Auditor for next year's Audit.
- **RBL Lease for the Annex:** The Clerk has been contacted by the regional manager Ms. Bunn and after discussion relating to the lease of the Annex the Council has received an email requesting a termination of their tenancy from the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017. It was Resolved: To accept the request from the RBL and terminate the lease from the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2017.
- 5) **Councillor Vacancies:** Several people have contacted the Clerk regarding the two Councillor vacancies; the Clerk has asked that they formally write in requesting to join the Council.
