- **85.** Conclusion of Audit 2017-18: The relevant paperwork having been previously circulated. It was Resolved: To note the completion of audit no recommendations having been raised.
- **86. Lomeshaye Development Brief Consultation:** The Chairman gave a brief update. **It was Resolved:** That the Chairman, Vice Chairman and Clerk draft a response to the consultation.
- **87.** Car Park Update: The Clerk circulated a financial report highlighting an uplift in the initial estimate through additional materials needed to conform to planning conditions and aesthetic considerations.

It was Resolved: To approve an increase of up to £5,000 on the original tender price.

88. Neighbourhood Plan Update: A short update was given by the Chairman regarding progress Cllr. Stringer reported that he had met a Planning Policy officer from Pendle BC and significant progress had been made with minor amendments to the draft. A meeting of the Steering Group would be convened when the Councils Consultants responded.

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- **89.** Pendle Borough Council Proposed Change to the Cycle of Elections Consultation: Pendle BC have discussed this at subcommittee level with the Corporate Director liaising with the Election Commission.
- 90. Transfer of Barrowford Memorial Park & Heritage Centre: The Transfer of the Heritage Centre and Barrowford Memorial Park has been included on the Agenda for the Pendle Borough Council meeting to be held 25th September 2018.
 It was Resolved: That Barrowford Parish Council still wished the Park and the Freehold of the Parkhill Estate (Heritage Centre) to be transferred to the Parish Council.

- **92. Report of the Clerk:** The Clerk gave a brief verbal report:
- 1) Remembrance Sunday: The Clerk reported that he had received an email from Mr. Sutcliff intimating that the Parade from Holmefield House to the Church was to be scrapped with the Parade starting at St. Thomas after the Service the Clerk asked what the Council would like.
 - It was Resolved: That the Parish Council as organisers would prefer the Parade to start at Holmefield House even if that meant the Parade moving straight from Holmefield House to the War Memorial for the Wreath Laying Ceremony. If this was to occur the Ceremony at the Memorial Park could be timed to coincide with the 11am "National two Minute Silence".
- 2) Road Barriers at Newbridge: The Clerk reported that the barrier had been damaged and that the Parish as the original purchasers of the barrier may be asked to contribute by the Highways Authority to the cost of repairs.
 It was Resolved: That the Council would in principle contribute towards the repairs the size of the contribution to be decided at a later date.
