- 56. Transfer of Barrowford Memorial Park: The Leader of Pendle Borough Council Cllr. Iqbal responding to a question at their last meeting stated that the Park and Heritage Centre would be transferred on the 1st September 2019. The question of the Parish Council appointing a solicitor to act on our behalf was raised. It was Resolved: To appoint a solicitor to act on the Councils behalf.
- **57. Neighbourhood Plan Update:** Cllr. Stringer reported that the Examiner had queried the origin of the map relating to Green Infrastructure and after discussions with Planning Policy it is recommended to adopt their newly drafted Green Infrastructure Map.

It was resolved: To use the new map.

59. Report of the Clerk:

- 1) **BWPAC Grant Application:** Barrowford PC has been awarded £3,000 towards refurbishment of the lights at Fountain Square. The Clerk is in the process of contacting the relevant officer at Together Housing to progress the work.
- 2) Best Kept Garden Competition: As of 16th July the Council has received 19 individual entries covering 34 class entries. Judging will take place Saturday 27th July meeting at Holmefield House at 10am.
- **3) Public Space Protection Orders (three year review & renewal):** Pendle have started their public consultation on the proposed draft renewal. Appendix 1 shows the email with copies of the old order and the proposed new order. The Council needs to respond by the 9th August 2019.
- 4) HRAG Meeting: A meeting was held last night; the Chairman gave a brief overview.
- 5) Former Belgarth Nursing Home: The Clerk received an email from a concerned resident over children using the building as a playground. The Clerk responded and forwarded the email to Borough Councillors and officers at Pendle. The Clerk has requested that the building be added to the Problem Building List.
- 6) **Barrowford in Bloom and Environmental Group:** The Clerk asked Pendle BC if they had the original deeds for the Fleece Toilets to try and establish ownership of the wall and railings. Pendle BC contacted the Clerk last week to say they had contacted

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Lancashire CC about ownership and maintenance responsibility and they would get back to the Clerk when they have had a response from LCC. The Clerk has emailed Mrs. J. Roscoe giving her a brief update; the item will be added to a later agenda for discussion and decision when ownership and responsibility for the railings is determined.

- 7) **Trees & Shrubbery at Broadway:** The trees and bushes need a significant pruning as each year they are encroaching further onto the grassed areas. The work needs to be carried out by someone with the correct experience in pruning. The Clerk is meeting a Barrowford contractor for an initial estimate.
- 8) Victoria Park: Cllr. Oliver reported that the waste bins were not being emptied the Clerk has phoned Pendle and also spoken to Cllr Nike regarding the bins in Barrowford Park. Bin emptying seems to be sporadic across both parks and the Clerk has emailed Mr. Roberts regarding the situation and had just received an email stating that the matter was being looked into.
- **60. Report on the Barrowford & Western Parishes Area Committee:** Cllr. Turner reported that the Area Committee had set aside £4,000 of its budget for capitol grants to community groups.
