Pendle Core Strategy Development Plan Document Notice of Public Consultation on Proposed Main Modifications

I am writing to you as you have previously expressed an interest in the preparation of the Pendle Core Strategy, or submitted a formal representation commenting on its content (N.B. this could have been submitted as a signatory to a petition).

The Core Strategy contains the strategic planning policies that will be used to manage development in the borough up to 2030. It is currently the subject of an independent examination, which is being conducted by Mr. Mark Dakeyne BA (Hons) MRTPI of the Planning Inspectorate (PINS).

On 18th June 2015, Greg Clark, the Secretary of State for Communities & Local Government published a Written Ministerial Statement announcing changes to the Government's Planning Practice Guidance for onshore wind turbine development. As a consequence Policy ENV3 of the Pendle Core Strategy, although not specifically referring to wind energy, is no longer considered consistent with national planning policy.

Pendle Council has proposed Main Modifications to Policy ENV3 (Reference: MM095-MM098 inclusive) to address this matter and the Inspector has requested that these be made available for public comment, before he issues his final report.

Consultation Period

Representations can be made until **5:00pm on Friday 18th September 2015.** Your comments should <u>ONLY</u> address Main Modifications (MM095-MM098) and concern matters of soundness and legal compliance.

This consultation does <u>NOT</u> provide a further opportunity to comment on the content of the Pendle Core Strategy or any other Main Modifications, as these have already been considered by the Inspector.
